**ATTORNEY GENERAL JOHN SUTHERS TO ADDRESS ETHICS AT ACCOUNTING EVEN

Greeley, Colo. -Colorado Attorney General John Suthers will give the keynote address during an event devoted to business ethics on April 8 at the University of Northern Colorado's Monfort College of Business.

Suthers' presentation, "Ethics: It's What You Do When No One's Watching," at 1:25 p.m. in Milne Auditorium of Kepner Hall will cap a day of sessions led by faculty and corporate experts as part of Accounting's second annual Fraud and Ethics Day for students.
